Concourse A Closure
(Upper Level Only)

Construction began on ANC South Terminal renovations December, 2006. This project includes:

- Seismic upgrades to meet current Federal standards
- Replacement of outdated mechanical and electrical systems for operational efficiency
- Increased curbside space and improved access and pedestrian flow to increase level of services for passengers arriving and departing the South Terminal
- Increased ticket lobby areas to accommodate queuing and improve circulation
- Upgrades to outbound baggage handling system to support the baggage screening process
- Improve passenger flow to accommodate additional retail, and food and beverage venues
- Architectural enhancements to increase natural lighting and create an attractive and pleasant airport experience


