

# Changes

## at Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport

Construction activities associated with the renovation of the South Terminal of Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport are underway and will be ongoing for the next two years. To ensure that you have a pleasant travel experience this summer, we would like to make you aware of the following changes at the Airport.

### **A** TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGE

During the 2007 construction season, the number of traffic lanes in front of the South Terminal will be reduced. The curbside area for passenger drop-off and pick-up areas on both the upper and lower ramps will also be reduced. Be alert to traffic pattern changes and signage directing passenger loading and off-loading activities.

### **B** NEW CELL PHONE WAITING AREA

To help reduce curbside congestion, a parking lot has been established for individuals awaiting cell phone calls from arriving passengers. Watch for directional signage to the cell phone waiting area. This parking lot is located west of the Jewel Lake/Spenard Road intersection.

### **C** ADDITIONAL PUBLIC PARKING TO OPEN MID-JULY

A new Rental Car Facility is scheduled to open in mid-July, at which time additional public parking will become available in the existing Airport parking garage.

### **D** FREE AIRPORT SHUTTLE

Shuttle bus service is available between the North and South Terminals and the Short/Long-term and Rental Car Parking Lots.

### **E** TICKETING AND PASSENGER CHECK-IN CHANGES
