




Central Region Construction Projects




ANCHORAGE

Earthquake repairs will be ongoing through the 2019 season at various locations.

- 1 Seward Hwy: MP 114 to Dimond Blvd. Pavement Preservation**
 This is a preventative maintenance project for resurfacing Seward Highway from mile post 114 to the Dimond Interchange. This may include signing, striping, signalization, automated traffic recorders, drainage, pavement, dig-outs, curb ramps, guardrail, bridge repair/deck overlays, lighting, and utility relocation.
- 2 AMATS: Abbott Rd Rehab - Phase II**
 Project will rehabilitate Abbott Road between Jupiter and Birch Road, including widening for 2-lanes with two-way-left-turn-lanes and including improvements to drainage, intersection, ADA, curb ramps, pathways and utilities.
- 3 HSIP: Jewel Lake Road Widening, 88th Ave to Strawberry**
 Construct a continuous two-way left-turn lane on Jewel Lake Road between 88th Avenue and Strawberry Road. Project work will include shoulder widening and pathway extension, as well as installing curbs and gutters, drainage, paving, signing, striping, and signalization.
- 4 AMATS: Rabbit Creek Road Pavement Preservation**
 Repave Rabbit Creek Road from Old Seward Highway to Hillside Drive. Project work will include excavating and backfilling soft spots in the road, replacing substandard guardrail and guardrail end terminals and installing new striping.
- 5 AMATS: Bicycle Plan Implementation (MOA Owned - Group 2)**
 Constructing bicycle facilities recommended by the March 2010 Anchorage Bicycle Plan. This is an areawide project, located in multiple areas within the Greater Anchorage Area.
- 6 Minnesota Drive: Seward to Tudor Pavement Preservation**
 This is a Preventive Maintenance (PM) project for resurfacing Minnesota Drive in Anchorage, Alaska from the Seward Highway to Tudor Road. It will also include, as necessary: guardrail, drainage, signalization, ADA curb ramp improvements, signs and striping.
- 7 C St: 40th to Minnesota & AMATS: Anchorage Areawide Trails Rehab - C Street Path**
 Project will mill and fill the existing footprint of the roadway including upgrades to curb ramps for ADA, drainage, signage and guardrail as needed.
- 8 5th Ave & 6th Ave Resurfacing, Karluk to Airport Heights**
 Resurfacing 5th Ave and 6th Ave including: milling, paving, minor subgrade rehabilitation, repair/replace lighting, ADA improvements, striping, signage and drainage.
- 9 AMATS: Anchorage Areawide Trails Rehab - Fish Creek Trail**
 Reconstruct Fish Creek Trail from Red Bridge Park to Taft Street and from Fish Creek Park to Barbara Street Park. Project work includes installing new pavement, four new bridges, and new lighting throughout the project.



- 10 Glenn Highway Capacity Improvements DB Phase II - Hiland to Artillery**
 Construct a new three lane bridge on the southbound Glenn Highway over Eagle River and a frontage road on the west side of the highway from Artillery Road to Highland Road.
- 11 Old Glenn Hwy: Artillery Road Interchange to W. Lake Ridge Dr. Pavement Preservation**
 This is a preventative maintenance project for resurfacing Old Glenn Highway from Artillery Rd to West Lake Ridge Rd. This may include signing, striping, signalization, automated traffic recorders, drainage, pavement, dig-outs, curb ramps, guardrail, bridge repair/deck overlays, lighting, and utility relocation.



- 12 Seward Hwy: MP 100-105 Improvements**
 The proposed project includes: rehabilitating the roadway, making drainage improvements, replacing Indian Creek Bridge, rehabilitating other bridges, and upgrading as necessary the signing, striping, and guardrail. The project will also provide roadway improvements to address safety issues caused by traffic flow disruption. Trail improvements and enhancements to increase safety at intersections and provide separation between motorized and non-motorized users is also included.
- 13 Seward Hwy: MP 75-90 Ingram Cr Girdwood Rd & Bridge Rehab Phase 1**
 Upgrades will include road resurfacing, road realignment, passing lanes, drainage improvements, shore protection improvements, and pedestrian facilities. This project will also include new bridges at Glacier, Virgin and Peterson Creeks, and the rehabilitation of the Ingram Creek bridge.
- 14 Whittier Tunnel Surface and Drainage Improvements**
 Winter construction to make improvements to drainage within the tunnel and stabilization of tunnel walls and ceiling to mitigate rock fall hazard.
