

Public Open House on the Homer Lake Street Rehabilitation and Pioneer Avenue Pavement Preservation

The Homer Lake Street project will rehabilitate Lake Street between the Sterling Highway and Pioneer Avenue/East End Road. This fall DOT&PF plans to begin the process of appraising property required for the construction. The project is intended to extend the life of the roadway, improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities, and improve drainage. The Pioneer Avenue Pavement Preservation project is kicking off design. This Preventive Maintenance (PM) project will resurface Pioneer Avenue from the Sterling Highway to Lake Street. The purpose of this project is to extend the service life of the roadway and reduce maintenance costs. To learn more about these projects please plan on attending the Open House event.
