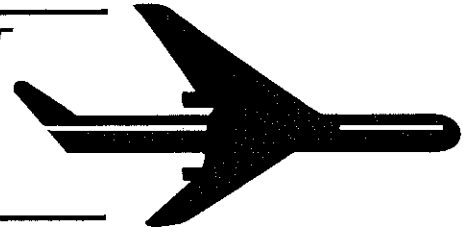
The application will contain the following questions:

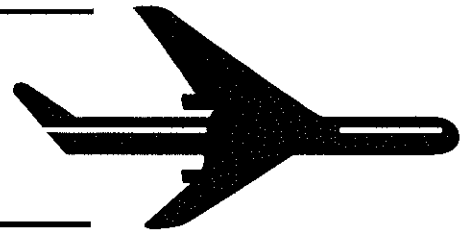
The Fairbanks International Airport Operators' council (AOC) has, in conjunction with the University of Alaska Fairbanks, established two annual \$500.00 scholarships to be awarded based on the following criteria:

1. The student must be an Alaskan Resident.
2. Must be enrolled as a Part or Full time student.
3. Must be a high school graduate with a 2.5 or higher GPA, or an older person (25 years or older) with selection being based on work experience.
4. Must have a previously demonstrated interest in the aviation field (i.e. job, hobby, club membership, etc.).
5. Must be interested in and oriented towards aviation or an airport related career.
6. Must have financial need.
7. The selected student will be invited to an AOC meeting for recognition.

The UAF scholarship committee will select the recipient using it's own criteria in addition to the items outlined here. Upon notification of a recipient, AOC will send the check to UAF. UAF will then ensure that the funds are used to pay educational expenses.
