McGrath Road Upgrade Project No. 0002300/Z628380000



The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (ADOT&PF), in cooperation with the Alaska Division of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to upgrade McGrath Road in Fairbanks, Alaska between the Old Steese Highway intersection (milepoint 0.000) and the Farmers Loop intersection (milepoint 2.87). The road work is expected to include the following:

- Road reconstruction and geometry improvements
- Shoulder widening and drainage improvements
- Closure of one Old Steese intersection
- Construction of a consistent offset separated attached path from Farmers Loop to Willow Grouse.
- Updates to approaches, culverts, guardrail, signing and striping

Project Purpose: Improve safety and reduce maintenance costs on McGrath Road

Current Status: The ADOT&PF has completed preliminary engineering and is now seeking comments on the current design plans. Comments will be sought at a December 7, 2017 open house. The deadline for submitting comments is January 31, 2018.
