## Parks Highway MP 305-325 Reconstruction Z606570000/0A45028



**Project Purpose:** The project will reduce load restrictions and increase safety for the traveling public by bringing the roadway up to current design standards. The project extends from the Tanana River Bridge at Nenana (milepost 305) to the Fairbanks North Star Borough boundary (milepost 325). Reconstruction will include:

- Realignment to reduce sharp curves and steep grades.
- New and upgraded passing lanes.
- Reconstructing and paving driveway and road approaches.
- Repaving to handle heavy traffic loads without seasonal load restrictions.
- Replacing Little Goldstream Creek Bridge near milepost 314.
- Rumble strips, signing, and striping.
- Tree and brush clearing for visibility.
- Upgrading mailboxes.
- Upgrading, relocating, and constructing new turnouts.

**Current Status:** The ADOT&PF has completed preliminary engineering and is now seeking comments on the current design.
