## MP 1354-1365 REHABILITATION




STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION & PUBLIC FACILITIES

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with Great Northwest, Inc., is working to rehabilitate the road surface and bridges on the Alaska Highway, from MP 1354 to 1365. Drainage culverts will be replaced as needed. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is expected to be complete by mid-September 2016.

### Planned Project Details:

- Work is expected to start April 18, 2016.
- Expect flagging and PILOT CAR operations, lane restrictions and DETOURS.
- The project will include replacing aging pavement, rehabilitating the Chief Creek and Bear Creek bridges, wayside improvements and guardrail and sign improvements.
- Major construction and excavation work from MP 1362 to 1364 is expected to take place from mid-June to mid-August.
