

AURORA AND AUBURN DRIVE RESURFACING

CITY OF FAIRBANKS PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES UPGRADE

The Alaska Department of Transportation is working to resurface portions of Aurora Drive and Auburn Drive as well as reconstruct pedestrian facilities along several Fairbanks streets. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction.

Planned Project Details:

- We will resurface .84 miles of roadway on Aurora Drive from Hanson Road to College Road, and .83 miles of roadway and .67 miles of bike path along Auburn Drive.
- Pedestrian facilities will be reconstructed on Aurora Drive; Cowles Street; Lacey Street; 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th Avenues from Cowles Street to Noble Street; and 10th Avenue from Noble Street to the Steese Highway.
