RIGHT TURN LANES

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with Paving Products, Inc., is working to install new right turn lanes on College Road. Upon project completion, there will be a new right turn lane for westbound traffic at the College Road/Old Steese Highway intersection, and a new right turn lane added (creating two right turn lanes) for eastbound traffic at the College Road/Steese Highway intersection. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is expected to be complete by October 2016.

Planned Project Details:

- A PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE will be held on Tuesday, May 24 at the Farthest North Girl Scout Council building (431 Old Steese Hwy #100) from 4:00pm to 5:00pm. During this time, project teams will be available to review the scope of work and provide information about this project.
- Work is expected to start Tuesday, May 31. At this time, be alert to a ROAD CLOSURE on College Road between the Old Steese and Steese Highways, through approximately Sunday, July 31.
 Follow construction signs for DETOUR routes along the Steese Highway to the Johansen Expressway (northbound), and along the Steese Highway to 3rd Street (southbound).
- Expect night work, with DETOURS and LANE CLOSURES.
