PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES UPGRADES

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, in partnership with Exclusive Paving, is working to improve pedestrian facilities, driveway approaches and sidewalk corners in the downtown Fairbanks area. This project will reconstruct pedestrian facilities on 5th Avenue between Barnette Street and Noble Street, as well as portions of 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th Avenues between Cushman Street and Noble Street. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is expected to be complete by October 31, 2016.

Planned Project Details:

- Work is currently scheduled to start in late July or early August.
- Work is expected to take place Monday through Saturday, from approximately 7:00am to 6:00pm.
- During construction, pedestrians can expect intermittent sidewalk CLOSURES.
