

# PEGER ROAD RESURFACING and FMATS PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS, STAGE I PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with Great Northwest, Inc., is working to resurface Peger Road, a portion of Phillips Field Road and the Peger Road/Johansen Expressway on and off ramps. Pedestrian facilities will also be constructed along Davis Road, Peger Road, Wilbur Street and Lathrop Street. Additionally, the department will upgrade the traffic signal interconnect from the Mitchell Expressway to the Johansen Expressway. We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. These projects are expected to be complete by September 2016.

## Planned Project Details:

- A PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE will be held on Wednesday, May 25 from 5:00pm to 7:00pm at the DOT Field Office (Peger Business Center, 3180 Peger Road, Suite 220). During this time, project teams will be available to review the scope of work and provide information about this project.
- Work is expected to start in early June. Working hours will be Monday through Saturday, from 7:00pm to 6:00am.
- Expect LANE CLOSURES, sidewalk CLOSURES and traffic signal shutdown during evening hours. Access to all businesses and residences will be maintained.
