We will do our best to keep you informed as work progresses and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is expected to be complete by late August 2016.

- Work is anticipated to start early June 2016.
- Please be aware, the road is CLOSED to public use until after the construction project is complete.
- This summer, the last four miles (near the bank of the Yukon River going east toward Manley) will be constructed.
