The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Alaska Division of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), invites you to an Open House to learn about the proposed increase of the speed limit on portions of the Richardson Highway between MP 17 (north of Valdez) and MP 264 (south of Delta Junction) to 65 MPH. The proposed changes are intended to reduce conflicts due to differences between traveling vehicles speeds and the posted speed limit.

- Current operating speed of traffic on the Richardson Highway
- Existing roadway alignment
- Lane and shoulder width
- Signing (regulatory, warning, and advisory speeds)
- School bus stop locations
- Crash history and crash severity
- Driveways and side street density
