Notice to Consultants:

Effective May 8, 2015, the Department, in coordination with the U.S. Department of Transportation, adopted a Race-Neutral Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program for its federal-aid program. The Race-Neutral DBE program applies to federally funded construction related professional services solicitations, with the exception of FAA funded projects located within the boundaries of the department's Northern Region, which remain under a Race-Conscious DBE program.

All consultant firms must register annually or prior to award with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Civil Rights Officer (CRO) by completing a consultant registration form (psa db e 25D-6) for each consultant and subconsultant.
