The RFP Package is hereby clarified or changed as follows:

1. Submittal deadline has not been changed:
2. QUESTION & ANSWERS

Q1: On page 11 of 45, B19.6.11, it calls for providing a 3R analysis under Task 12. Should that notation be Task 3 Traffic and Safety Analysis?

A1: This addendum corrects what task Article B19.6.11 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (3R) Analysis is under. See item #6 below.

Q2: Is the 3R analysis described in B19.6.11 limited to the interchange on-ramp locations identified in the ICM study in Exhibit B7, as opposed to the entire corridor?

A2: The Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (3R) Analysis applies to the entire project per the Preconstruction Manual.

Q3: Should the individual performing the Traffic & Safety Analysis be an Alaskan registered engineer? It is currently not noted with an \*.

A3: Yes, we require a registered professional engineer for Traffic & Safety Analysis. See item #8 below.

Q4: For the Environmental Document/Permitting Support function, I didn't see a task related to this anywhere in the statement of services. Is there something missing in the SOS or do we not need to identify someone for that task?

A4: Reference Article B23.3.3, the Contractor will be required to provide supporting information for the document preparation to the Contracting Agency. See items #8 and #9 below.

3. Reference RFP Package, Statement of Services, Article B19.6.2 ITS Systems Engineering Analysis, remove and replace with the following:

**“B19.6.2 ITS Systems Engineering Analysis**, if applicable, provided by the Contractor under this section (Task 4).”

4. Reference RFP Package, Statement of Services, Article B19.6.6 Hydraulic or Hydrologic Report, remove and replace with the following:

**“B19.6.6 Hydraulic or Hydrologic Report**, provided by Contractor under Task 2.”

5. Reference RFP Package, Statement of Services, B19.6.10 Traffic Analysis Report, remove and replace with the following:

**“B19.6.10 Traffic Analysis Report**, provided by Contractor under Task 3.”

6. Reference RFP Package, Statement of Services, Article B19.6.11 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (3R) Analysis: remove and replace with the following:

**“B19.6.11 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (3R) Analysis**, provided by the Contractor under this section (Task 4) and in accordance with Section 1160 of the Preconstruction Manual. Include a discussion in the body of the DSR summarizing the findings as required in Section 450 of the Preconstruction Manual.”

7. Reference RFP Package, Statement of Services, Article 19.7 Deliverable Items, Type of Document - 3R Analysis row, Paragraph column, remove “B19.6.1” and replace with “B19.6.11”.

8. Reference RFP Package, Appendix C, Evaluation Criterion 4, Proposed Project Staff, remove and replace with Attachment 1.

9. Reference RFP Package, Appendix C, Evaluation Criterion 8, Proposed Project Staff for Possible Added Services, remove and replace with Attachment 2.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
