The RFP Package is hereby clarified or changed as follows:

1. The proposal due date remains unchanged.
2. Proposer Questions & Answers:
 - Q. [What is the] role of the construction surveyor? Is this a full time on-site position, or a part-time role that can be filled remotely?
 - A. The role of the consultant's surveyor is to assist the project engineer with spot checking survey performed by the Contractor. The consultant's surveyor need only be onsite as necessary for the consultant to fulfill their obligations under Section 9.2 of the Alaska Construction Manual. The project includes unclassified excavation and laying out airport striping; survey for this and other work will need to be checked according to ACM Section 9.2. The consultant is required to spot check "...at least 5%..." of survey for items measured for payment by the contractor, and to spot check note reductions and other survey work for accuracy. Reference Appendix 18.15, Surveying and Staking, for "acceptable procedures for consultant or contractor forces performing construction surveys," and Section G-135-3.1 of the specifications requiring the Contractor to provide "72 hours' notice before performing work, and furnish the appropriate data, to allow for random spot checking."

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
