

# ANGOON AIRPORT TYPICAL RIGHT-OF-WAY PROCESS



#### **Title**

 Property owners of record or heirs get identified.





## **Design Approval**

- FAA approves airport layout and property use.
- Right-of-way (ROW)
   design determines
   what parcels and uses
   are necessary for
   the project.





# **Appraisal**

- Independent appraiser assesses fair market property values.
   Owners or heirs are invited to join appraisal visits.
- Appraiser sends DOT&PF appraisal reports on fair market property values.
- Appraisals are reviewed and just compensation is determined.





### **Offers**

- DOT&PF makes offers based on just compensation.
- Owners or heirs have an opportunity to discuss the offer with DOT&PF or its ROW consultant.





## Closing

 Property is transferred, and DOT&PF pays owners or heirs.

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All right-of-way processes follow the consumer protections laid out in the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (the Uniform Act). For more information, see
