High	Approach Railing-Repair	1355	Replace missing bolts on FE US and FE DS transitions.	
High	Bridge Rail-Repair (LF)	7	Install missing nuts on rail post connections to deck - approximately 10 places.	
Medium	Channel-Remove Debris (EA)	1	Periodically remove drift and debris from piers to prevent scour.	
Low	Substructure-Patch spalls (LF)	3	Chip to sound concrete, clean and coat exposed reinforcing steel and patch spalled area in hider wall FE DS side. Place fill under abutment FE.	
Low	Misc-Install Sign (EA)	1	Install name place sign NE DS side.	

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Element Inspection

Element	Description	Observations
12	Reinforced Concrete Deck	Most delaminations are near highway centerline and around previously patched areas especially at the FE of the bridge. About 25% delams in the SB and minimal delams in the NB lane. Deck cracking is prevalent and many patches are cracked. About 15 spalls have been filled with asphalt. Minor amount of transverse cracking with efflorescence in soffit overhangs.

> 1130	Cracking (RC and Other)	
107	Steel Open Girder/Beam	Minor rust freckles on girders, cross frames, and lateral bracing with combined area less than 1% of total painted area. Second and sixth transverse stiffeners from the NE on the US girder are bent. Swallows nests on the lateral bracing connection plates.
> 515	Steel Protective Coating	
210	Reinforced Concrete Pier Wall	Vertical cracks on both faces of both piers. Crack width of about 1/16 inch for the full height of the pier at about centerline. Some locations behind steel nosing armor sound hollow as if it is not in direct contact with concrete. Pier 3 has a tight horizontal crack about 6 feet above the waterline.
215	Reinforced Concrete Abutment	Some honeycombed section in NE backwall but concrete is sound. FE backwall has 1/16 inch vertical cracks at four locations. Two piles are exposed under the FE abutment. Near the centerline of the bridge, the edge of the pile is within about 1 inch of the front face of the concrete pile cap beam. Backwalls have vertical cracks FE DS hider wall has 8 inch x 3 inch spall with exposed reinforcing that is rusting. Dirt on caps
304	Open Expansion Joint	At both abutments, one side of the finger joints is about 1/4 inch higher than the other. No apparent problems appear to have resulted in this height differential. Spall in the FE DS end of the expansion joint concrete.
311	Movable Bearing	Expansion bearings at abutments are damaged but functional. Paint system has failed and the PTFE laminations are delaminated and damaged. Bearings appear to be functional and are in a fully expanded position at this and other recent inspections.

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330	Metal Bridge Railing	Loose lower rail to post bolt FE DS Post #11 NE DS Post #2 missing both lower compression bolts post to deck. Post #1 missing 1. First 3 posts on NE DS are leaning towards NE. Broken post to PL welds and damaged rail (NE at about 213 feet to 236 feet)

600	Signs Smart Flag	NE name place sign is missing.
602	Approach Rail Smart Flag	The bolts connecting the vertical angle to the Thrie beam in the FE US transition are missing. Three nuts are missing on the FE DS transition rail posts. FE DS thrie-beam transition is damaged. All approach rails have minor damage.








