The **Copper River Watershed Project** will be applying herbicide on DOT&PF rights-of-way in **Cordova** on or after **August 14, 2015** (weather dependent, **one application**).

In accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Integrated Vegetation Management Plan (IVMP), the Copper River Watershed Project intends to begin using herbicides as a maintenance tool, along with non-chemical treatments, to treat reed canarygrass (*Phalaris arundinacea*) on ADOT&PF rights-of-way in the Cordova area. Treatment will occur on select infestations of invasive plants along both sides of the Copper River Highway between MP 2-6 and Whitshed Road between MP 0 -2 during August and September 2015. Each location will receive one application. AquaMaster (EPA No. 524-343) will be applied via backpack sprayer.
