Notice of Intent to Begin Integrated Vegetation Management Plan Activity

Title

In accordance with the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (ADOT&PF) Integrated Vegetation Management Plan (IVMP), the Salcha-Delta Soil and Water Conservation District intends to use herbicides as a maintenance tool to treat Bird Vetch (*Vicia cracca*), White Sweet Clover (*Melilotus alba*), Yellow Toadflax (*Linaria vulgaris*), and Perennial Sow Thistle (*Sonchus arvensis*) within ADOT&PF rights-of-way in the Delta area. The treatments will occur on select infestations of noxious weeds

along School Road, Clearwater Road, Tanana Loop Extension, Jack Warren Road, and the Richardson Highway between MP 274 – MP 294.
