Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Draft Northwest Alaska Transportation Plan. The National Park Service's comments on the plan are as follows:

1. Page 1: Chapter 1. Introduction. The introduction should indicate the duration of the plan (i.e., 20-years).
2. Page 5-9, Table 5-4. The table should be footnoted to indicate that the Anaktuvuk Pass to Dalton Highway/Spur from Proposed Foothills Road is beyond the Plans 20-year timeframe and would not be considered for development. This would also apply to other potential roads that are not feasible during the life of the plan.
