## Eligibility requirements for applying for human services funds: (FTA Section 5310, 5317, 5316, AMHTA and State Match)

- Eligible organizations:
  - Non-profit organizations
  - o Brokers (with nonprofit status)
  - o Small urban public transit
  - o Rural public transit
  - Operators of public transportation services including private operators of public transportation services.
  - o Tribal governments
  - Local governments
  - Non-profit and governmental organizations who serve the Alaska Mental Health Trust Beneficiaries
- Participate in the Public Transit-Human Services Community Coordination Plan. If there is not
  current plan in your community, one must be created before applying for funding. (Note: Planning
  applications are exempt from this requirement if applying for funds to create a new plan.) See link
