

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN
ALASKA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS SYSTEM OTHER RATES AND FEES
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION & PUBLIC FACILITIES**

Notice is given that the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), under authority vested by AS 2.15.020 and Title 17 AAC 42.125, intends to modify certain fees listed below for the Alaska International Airports System (AIAS), consisting of the Ted Stevens Anchorage (ANC) and Fairbanks (FAI) International Airports. The proposed rates will become effective **July 1, 2022**, but landing fees will not affect aircraft of less than 6,000 pounds Certificated Maximum Gross Takeoff Weight (CMGTW). Signatory Airlines are air carriers that have executed an AIAS Operating Agreement and Passenger Terminal Lease (Operating Agreement). Copies of the Operating Agreement are available at http://dot.alaska.gov/aias/op_agreements.shtml or upon request from the airport leasing offices.

The proposed Other Rates and Fees changes are summarized as follows and are subject to change by further public notice at any time:
