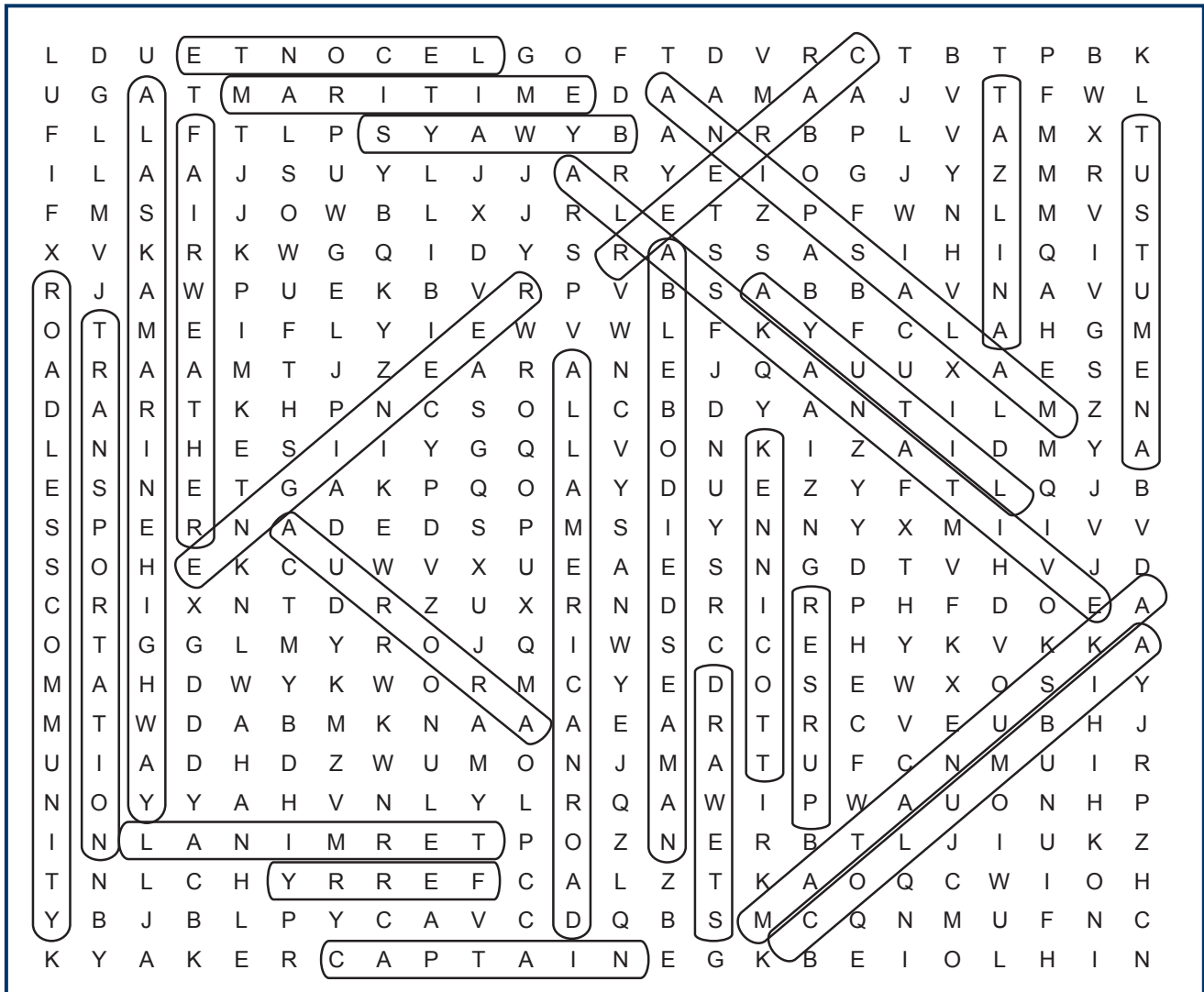

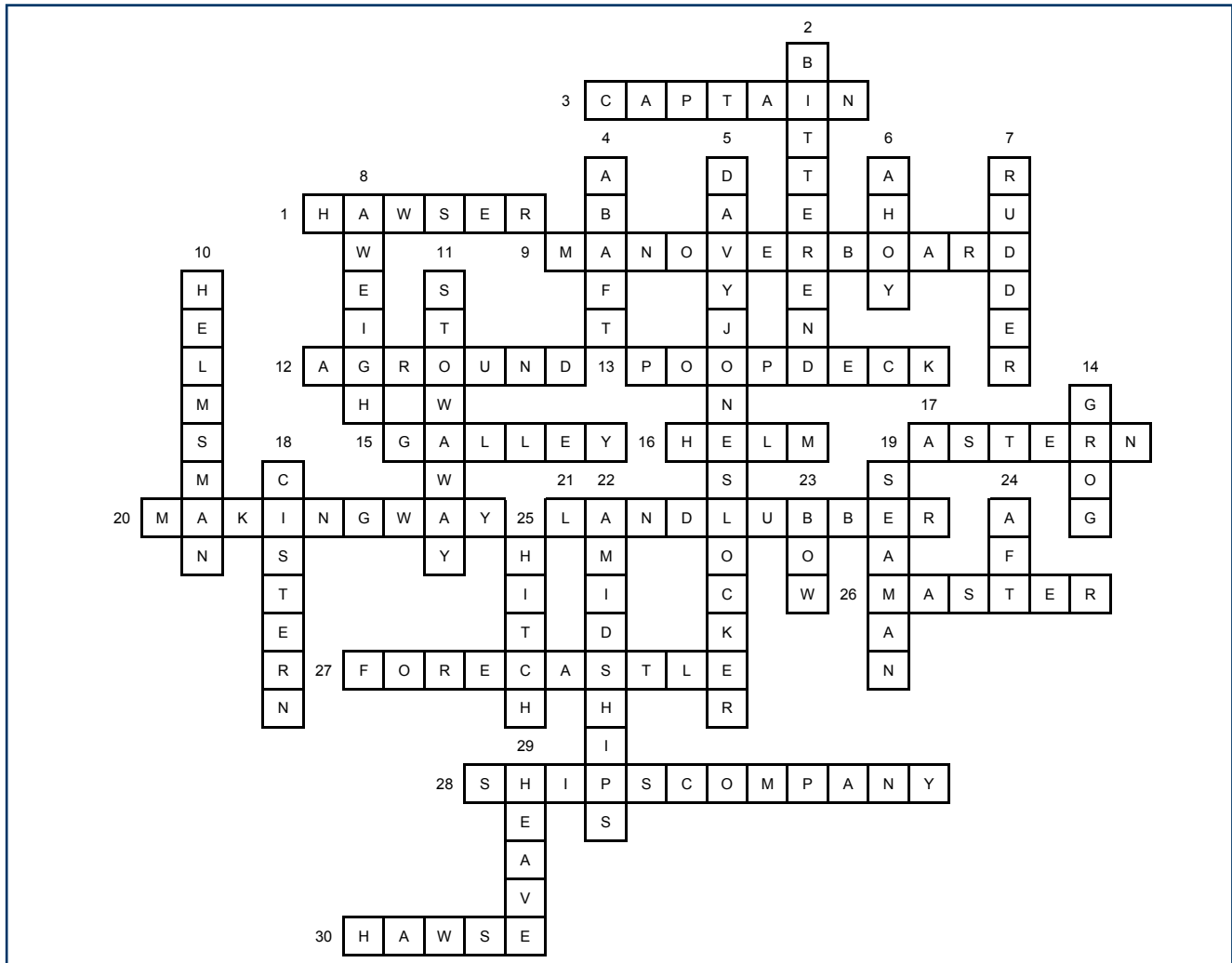
# PORT COMMUNITIES

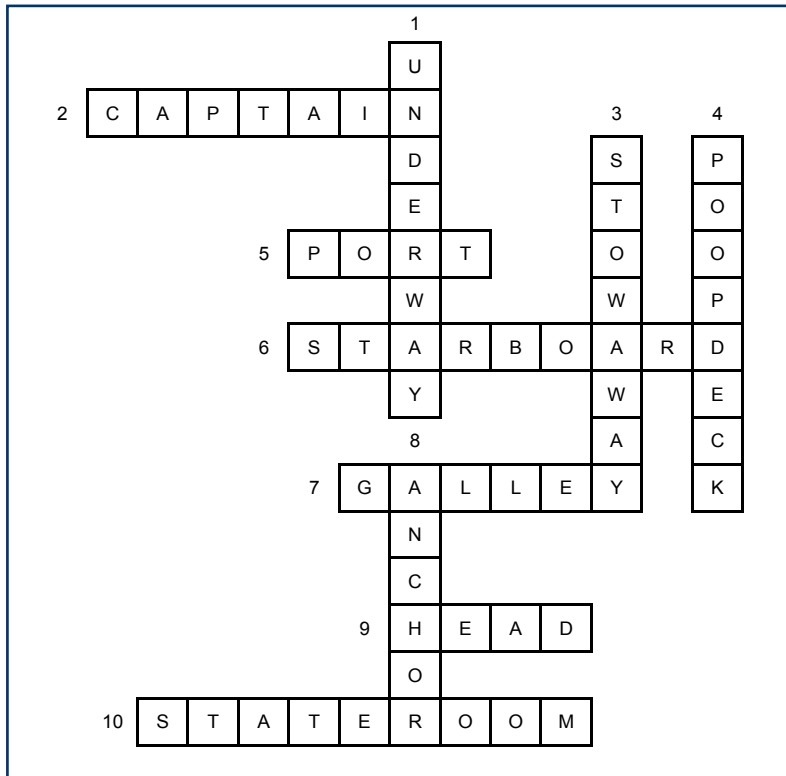
