The Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) has released its 2021-2022 winter and summer schedules.

The newly released AMHS schedules cover ferry travel from October 2021 through September 2022.

Reservations are available for booking at FerryAlaska.com, by calling 1-800-642-0066, or visiting ferry terminal staff throughout the system.

The release of the 2021-2022 schedules followed public comment periods held in July and August. The comment periods were an opportunity for communities and individuals to review and comment on the proposed schedules and alert AMHS to significant community events.
