






Aluminum boxes (manufactured at our shipyard) will be employed for seamless loading and unloading of cargo at each port.





Hand trollers, power trollers, etc. represent small, family-owned businesses. In many rural places the logistics of fish delivery creates a major business roadblock. Frequent, high-speed ferry service with an ability to transfer fresh fish will be an economic game-changer.



A private/public partnership would put Alaskans back to work in a meaningful way that helps other Alaskans. It would also open a door for shoreside entrepreneurial opportunities (cargo delivery, vehicle rentals, etc.)









Contractual relationships between Allen Marine and the Alaska Marine Highway date back to 2005. Since the initial contract, there have been several circumstances in which our Alaskan-owned company has provided interim service. In 2020, both Goldbelt and Allen Marine were awarded contracts to fill service gaps.
