
Administrative Assistant I, Fairbanks International Airport







Annual Operating Revenues and Operations, Maintenance and Debt Costs

AIAS FY2017 Annual Operating Costs and DSC** (\$148.43 Million)




Cargo / PAX Activity

AIAS FY14 - FY18 YTD Monthly Reported Combined Cargo - Pax CMGTW As of December 31, 2017




Passenger Activity

Down 0.7% FY17 / Down 0.8% FY18 ytd




AIAS FY14 - FY18 YTD Monthly Enplanements As of December 31, 2017




FY2019 DOT&PF Results Delivery Units (RDU)
