SEWARD HIGHWAY CLOSURES Bird Creek and Hope Turn-off



The Alaska Department of Transportation is working in partnership with Granite Construction to rehabilitate the Seward Highway from approximately MP 99 to 100. Upon completion, they will widen the highway for a passing lane on the northbound side of the highway, make drainage improvements, and upgrade as necessary signage, striping, and guardrail. This project is scheduled to be complete by November 2015.

Also, the Alaska Department of Transportation is working in partnership with Pruhs Construction to repave the Seward Highway from MP 50 to MP 75. This project includes upgraded guardrail, signage, drain restoration, and minor structural repairs in selected locations. Bridge deck rehabilitation and bridge rail upgrades will be performed on Sixmile Creek Bridge No.615, Granite Creek Bridge No.616, and Canyon Creek Bridge No.1964. This project is scheduled to be complete by October 2015.



Beginning Monday, July 27, the Seward Highway will be **CLOSED** nightly from MP 52 to 52.5, just south of the Hope Highway for one hour between 9:30pm and 10:30pm, Monday through Thursday, through August 27. The **CLOSURES** on the Seward Highway at MP 99 to 100, just south of Bird Creek will continue on Tuesday, July 28 and Thursday, July 30, also between 9:30pm and 10:30pm, at which time the Seward Highway will be **CLOSED** simultaneously in both locations. Please plan accordingly.
