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

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

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

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

Project Description: This project will construction improvements to approximately 6,000 feet of existing underground water main pipes by trenchless techniques that serve the North Terminal, Concourse C, Concourse A, and the old Airfield Maintenance Building at Anchorage International Airport. All hydrants and water valves that are encountered will be replaced and additional valves will be installed where needed. A section of water main located under Concourse A with a valve that is currently closed and no longer in use will be abandoned.

Project Purpose: The existing water mains provide water for firefighting protection for the Terminal and old Airfield Maintenance Building. The pipes are estimated to have between 5-15 years of remaining life and require lining to extend their useful life and prevent the loss of service that could create a safety risk.

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

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

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

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




Glenn/Parks Interchange Repairs - Nov 2018 EQ PR Construction Map

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

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

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




Central Region Guardrail Inventory and Upgrade South (HSIP) Construction Map

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

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

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



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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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
