Project Overview

The proposed Sterling Highway Pavement Preservation project will resurface the highway between Mileposts 43 and 56 with the exception of the area between Milepost 44 and 47 which is within the Sterling Highway MP 45-60 Stage 1B project limits. Additional improvements may include: structural section repairs, upgrading roadside hardware, guardrail, signing and striping, clearing and grubbing, utility work, and minor bridge work.
