The purpose of the following information is to give project managers a general understanding of the environmental process the associated timelines. The times provided are only estimates and are dependent on a project's scope. Each task involves preparing documents, reviews, and coordinating with various public entities and agencies. The time each task takes is dependent on receiving responses from those public entities and agencies.

State Funded

Although many of the steps in the State Funded environmental process appear the same as the Federally Funded process, the approval processes and the language used for each task is very specific to the funding source. If a project switches from state to federal funding, the new approval authority will make the determination of what tasks satisfy the Federal Funding process requirements.
