PARKS HWY: HOUSTON TO WILLOW REHABILITATION

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is working on a project to rehabilitate and resurface the section of the Parks Highway between Mileposts 52 and 72. (Big Lake Road to Willow)

Project Scope

The project will resurface the roadway and address structural, drainage, and safety issues. Horizontal and vertical curves that do not meet current design standards and have a history of crashes will be upgraded. Moose crash mitigation measures may also be incorporated. Other safety improvements will include shoulder widening, signs, guardrail, and striping.

Potential Right of Way Impacts

Public Use Easements and/or Temporary Construction Easements may be required in some areas. No large permanent acquisitions are anticipated at this time.

Potential Construction Impacts

Work will be done at night whenever feasible, and temporary lane closures will likely occur.

Current Work

Crash data has been collected and analyzed and preliminary design work has begun.

Schedule

Construction is anticipated in 2024 or later, depending on availability of funds.
