Victory Road Pavement Preservation *Project No. 0001(726)/CFHWY00672*

Project Scope

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is proposing to resurface Victory Road from the intersection of the Glenn Highway to the Victory Bible Camp entrance. Additional work may include:

- Evaluating the structural section
- Improving drainage facilities, including ditches and culverts
 - Evaluating downstream impacts to the Glenn Highway
- Dig-outs
- Replacement or installation of:
 - Guardrail and guardrail end treatments
 - Signs, roadside hardware, and striping
- Relocating or adjusting utilities
- Vegetation clearing and grubbing

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety, extend the service life of the roadway, and reduce maintenance costs on Victory Road. The existing roadway is cracked and deteriorating due to erosion and settling. This project is to be constructed with the northern phase of the Glenn Highway MP 66.5 to 92 Pavement Preservation project.

Current Status

Preliminary design work and environmental analysis has begun and is expected to continue through 2022

Schedule

Preliminary Design – Spring 2022 through Fall 2022

Final Design – Winter 2022 through Spring 2024

Construction – Summer 2024

* Construction schedule is dependent on many factors including the progress of the Glenn Highway Pavement Preservation project and availability of funding.
