SUBJECT: Memorandum to Reviewers for PIH/PS&E Review Documents

This submittal includes PIH/PS&E review documents for the Anchorage Area Drainage Preservation Project, which includes:

- Dimond Boulevard: Jewel Lake Road to Seward Highway
- Seward Highway: Tudor Road to 20th Avenue

This memorandum provides additional context for your review.

Project Background

An inspection of the storm drain system was conducted for both the Dimond Boulevard and Seward Highway pavement preservation projects. The inspection included visual assessment, photographic documentation, video footage, and CCTV inspection.

In coordination with DOT&PF, it was determined that a separate Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) project is required prior to the pavement preservation work.

Scope of Work

The Anchorage Area Drainage Preservation Project includes:

- Cleaning of pipes 24 inches and smaller that were unable to be inspected
- CIPP lining for candidate pipes with a diameter of 24 inches or smaller
- Cleaning of all structures associated with the CIPP pipes

Larger CIPP lining candidate pipes requiring excavation (due to potential impacts on utilities, curbs, sidewalks, or surface infrastructure) will be addressed in the pavement preservation projects.

Documentation

Photos of each CIPP pipe will be included in the plans to document the condition at the time of inspection. This will establish a clear basis for evaluating any changes in conditions at the time of work compared to the original inspection.
