

# Join us for an Open House

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough (MSB), is proposing to reconstruct and extend Hemmer Rd north from its intersection with Palmer-Wasilla Highway to the intersection with Bogard Road. The improved Hemmer Road is proposed to have:

- 12-foot lanes (one in each direction) with 4-foot shoulders on each side
- pedestrian accommodation
- drainage improvements
- a new traffic signal at Bogard Road
