
Proposed Work

- Drainage improvements
- Culvert maintenance, replacement, and new installations
- Ditch grading
- Digouts and associated resurfacing
- Guardrail
- Signage
- Utility relocations
- Clearing and grubbing

Project Phasing

The project is being developed in phases for design and construction.

- <u>Phase 1</u> will replace 10 culverts in critical condition.
- <u>Phase 2</u> will replace the 144-inch culvert at Railroad Creek (MP 128.5) with a bridge.
- <u>Future project phases</u> will address roughly 200 remaining culverts in the project corridor.





The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by DOT&PF pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated November 3, 2017, and executed by FHWA and DOT&PF.
