

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program

The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program at the Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) operates primarily under four U.S. Department of Transportation administrations:

- ❑ Federal Transit Administration (FTA)
- ❑ Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)
- ❑ Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)
- ❑ Federal Maritime Administration (MARAD)

The MOA is a recipient of federal dollars, and it is OFC's duty to ensure that the MOA is complying with all provisions of the Code of Federal Regulations 49 Part 26

Implementation of the program is accorded the same priority as compliance with all other legal obligations incurred by the MOA in its financial assistance agreements with the federal DOT

The MOA has established a DBE program in accordance with regulations of the U.S. DOT 49 CFR 26.

- ❑ This program applies to all contracts funded wholly or in part with financial assistance from the Federal DOT and its operating elements (FTA, FAA, FHWA, MARAD)

Additionally, this program complies with the requirements of Anchorage Municipal Code 7.60.


Title VI

Civil Rights Act of 1964

The Municipality of Anchorage assures that no person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity of the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, or creed as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related acts.

Office of Federal Compliance oversees Title VI programs in the following departments:

- ❑ Public Transit
 - Federal Transit Administration
- ❑ Merrill Field Airport
 - Federal Aviation Administration
- ❑ Anchorage Water & Wastewater Utility
 - Environmental Protection Agency
- ❑ Don Young Port of Alaska
 - Maritime Administration

Objectives for Office of Federal Compliance

(Formerly Office of Equal Opportunity)

- To ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT-assisted contracts in the Department's highway, transit, and airport financial assistance programs
- To create a level playing field on which DBEs can compete fairly for DOT-assisted contracts
- To ensure that only firms that fully meet DBE eligibility standards are permitted to participate as DBEs
- Ensure that Minority, Disadvantaged, Woman-owned and Small Businesses have equal opportunity
- Ensure the Municipality of Anchorage is federally compliant under Title VI
- Ensure employees and people doing business with the Municipality of Anchorage are treated fairly
- Require that contractors, tenants, and concessionaires require Title VI assurances of their subcontractors.
- Ensure meaningful access to programs and activities by persons with limited English proficiency (LEP) under Title VI.

▶ Projects Fiscal Year 2026


1. ITS Upgrade Phase 3- Farebox Replacement - \$2,000,000


