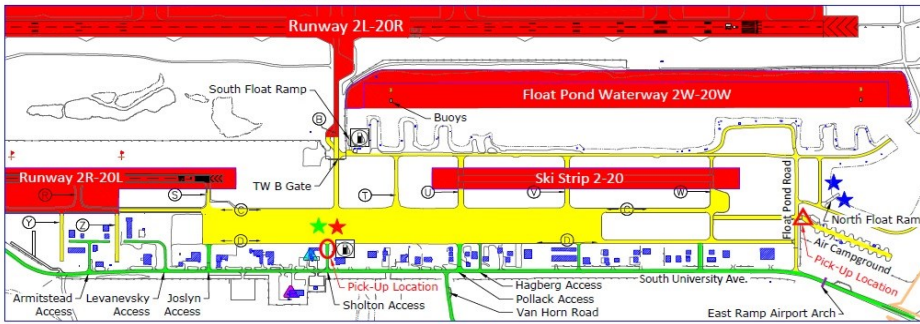
BUSINESS OFFICE CONTACT

There is no application fee. Tiedown fees are payable semiannually in advance on or before June 30 and December 31 each year. Fees are pro-rated, ensuring that permittees are billed fairly for the duration of rental.

Legend

- **Tower Clearance Required** - Any access to the surfaces depicted in RED requires clearance from the tower, (Aircraft Use Only). These surfaces are marked with red hold signs and yellow hold lines painted across access points. Do not cross without tower clearance. Entering these areas without clearance will result in severe penalties and could cause an aircraft accident.
- **Aircraft Operations Area**. Use extreme caution in areas depicted in Yellow. Aircraft always have the right of way and may be behind you. Always take the most direct route to your destination. Maximum Speed Limit is 20 mph. Taxiway Delta is NOT to be used as a vehicle roadway. Except for short distances, use University Avenue.
- **Public Access Roads** are depicted in Green.

HELPFUL TIPS

Help Keep Fairbanks Airport East Ramp Looking Great!

If you have old pieces of broken or unusable equipment on your spot, remove and dispose of them properly.

If your space has an abandoned or unused vehicle permanently parked on it, relocate to another place.

If your space is overgrown, Summer is a great time to clear brush & mow. Check to see if your Tiedowns are in need of repair and reach out to the Tiedown Office for assistance.

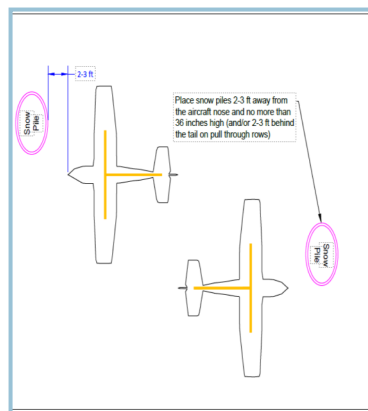
Fuel Tank Safety Check

Perform a safety check on any tanks and hoses on your Tiedown space & make any upgrades necessary to comply with Alaska regulations.

Snow Removal

FAI Tiedown permittees may remove snow from their spaces and position it for later removal by Airport staff, provided it is kept as close as possible to the tiedown space. Snow may not be moved or positioned across adjoining Tiedown spaces, taxiways, taxi lanes, parking rows, nor in any manner that creates a hazard or blocks vehicle or aircraft access to the parking row. Snow piles must be kept as low as possible, no higher than 36".

PILOTS LOUNGE

TIEDOWN BUILDING PERMITS

Only Float Pond & Gravel Tiedown Permittees are permitted to set up, or transfer, a storage shed and a fuel storage tank on their leased space. Additionally, Float Pond Permittees are permitted to build a dock.

The Tiedown Office must receive written approval to add or transfer any building or fuel tanks on leased property.

Report uncontrollable spills & spills in excess of 10 gallons or more to **Dispatch at 907.474.2530**.

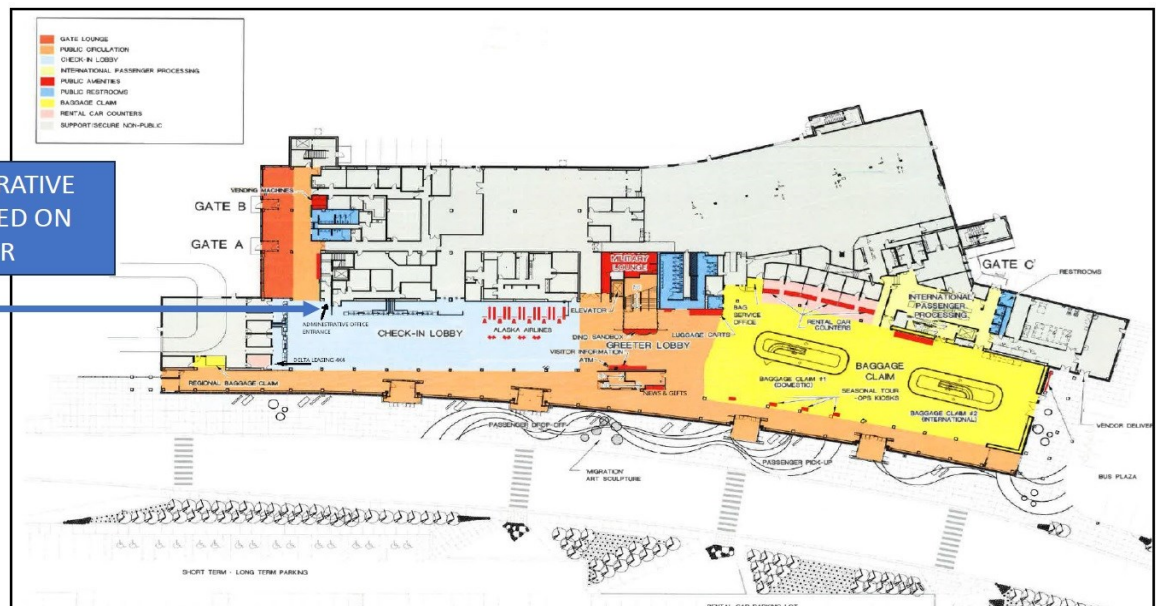
If you discover a spill, report it to Dispatch even if you are not the person responsible for the spill.
