ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SHIFT WORK

The career of an Emergency Services Dispatcher I/II is a 24 hour, seven (7) day a week job. You will be expected even as a Trainee to work holidays, birthdays, bad weather and weekends without fail.

While in training you will be assigned to a shift in which a Dispatch Trainer is present. You will be expected to work all assigned shifts without exception. After the training period, shifts are assigned in accordance with the needs of the Center per ASEA Local 52 Union Contract Article 27. Seniority shall be considered in assigning Dispatchers to desired shift assignments.

Days off will normally be rotating during the training period. Rarely, as a new recruit will you have assigned days off of Saturday and Sunday.

Full-time Dispatch shifts consist of the shifts below. Full-time Dispatchers may be assigned to work on Thursdays when needed.

A Shift – Monday -Wednesday 0600-1830

B Shift – Monday -Wednesday 1800-0630

C Shift – Friday - Sunday 0600-1830

D Shift – Friday - Sunday 1800-0630

E Shift – Wednesday through Saturday, varying hours (Wed 1800-0100,

Thurs 1800-0630, Fri 1800-0300, Sat 1800-0300).

This Supplemental Shift will also cover the shift when a dispatcher is on leave and will change to mirror that shifts' hours. The start/end times on Wed, Fri & Sat may be slightly adjusted as long as it is beneficial for the dispatch center. The Thurs time cannot change unless covering another shift.
