## **Commercial Vehicle Registration**

The State of Alaska does not participate in the International Registration Plan (IRP). All commercial vehicles that enter the State of Alaska must obtain an Alaskan registration.

Alaskan registration information can be found online from the Alaska DMV at <a href="http://doa.alaska.gov/dmv/reg/comveh.htm">http://doa.alaska.gov/dmv/reg/comveh.htm</a> and can be obtained at the Tok DMV. Please see Tok DMV hours of operation available at <a href="http://www.alaska.gov/dmv/office">www.alaska.gov/dmv/office</a> to coordinate your visit.

Unregistered vehicles that proceed beyond Tok will be subject to citations and may be liable in any incident involving an unregistered vehicle.

Temporary Registration for Truck or Trailer (TRT) can be obtained online at myalaska.gov, at the Tok Weigh Station, or at the Tok DMV.

## **MyAlaska Temporary Registration:**

If a vehicle does not have permanent registration in Alaska, a temporary registration can be purchased. The vehicle MUST have a current registration in a different state/province and the company's USDOT (MCS 150) number MUST have been updated within the last 24 months.

Temporary registrations are valid for 30 days. A certificate of temporary registration may be issued for a commercial vehicle even if a certificate of temporary registration has previously been issued for the vehicle and has expired.

Temporary registrations cost \$350 for a power unit (truck/truck tractor/van/etc.), and \$10 for a cargo carrying unit (trailer).

Temporary registrations are not refundable.

When ordering a TRT for the **first** time, a new account must be established. Once established:

- 1. Select "View Your Services"
- 2. Select "Measurement Standards and Commercial Vehicle Enforcement" under the Businesses section.
- 3. Select the option *Temporary Truck/Trailer Registration*.
- 4. This directs you to Customer Information page. Enter your information, hit Save and Continue.
- 5. Complete all required information including yellow highlighted areas, provide payment, and then print out completed TRT. (*NOT VALID FOR TRAVEL IS A REVIEW PAGE*.)

A Certificate of Temporary Registration allows the operation of commercial vehicles in the State of Alaska that are currently registered/licensed in another state or jurisdiction. Proof of current registration must be presented at the time the permit is issued.
