The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (ADOT&PF), in cooperation with the Alaska Division of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to reconstruct Gillam Way in Fairbanks, AK between Airport Way and 22nd Avenue. The reconstruction includes the following:

- Repaving
- Intersection improvements
- Addition of shared bicycle shoulders
- Improving existing and constructing new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) sidewalks throughout the project limits
- Traffic calming features
- Drainage improvements
- Updated signage

Project Purpose: Improve safety and reduce maintenance costs on Gillam Way.
