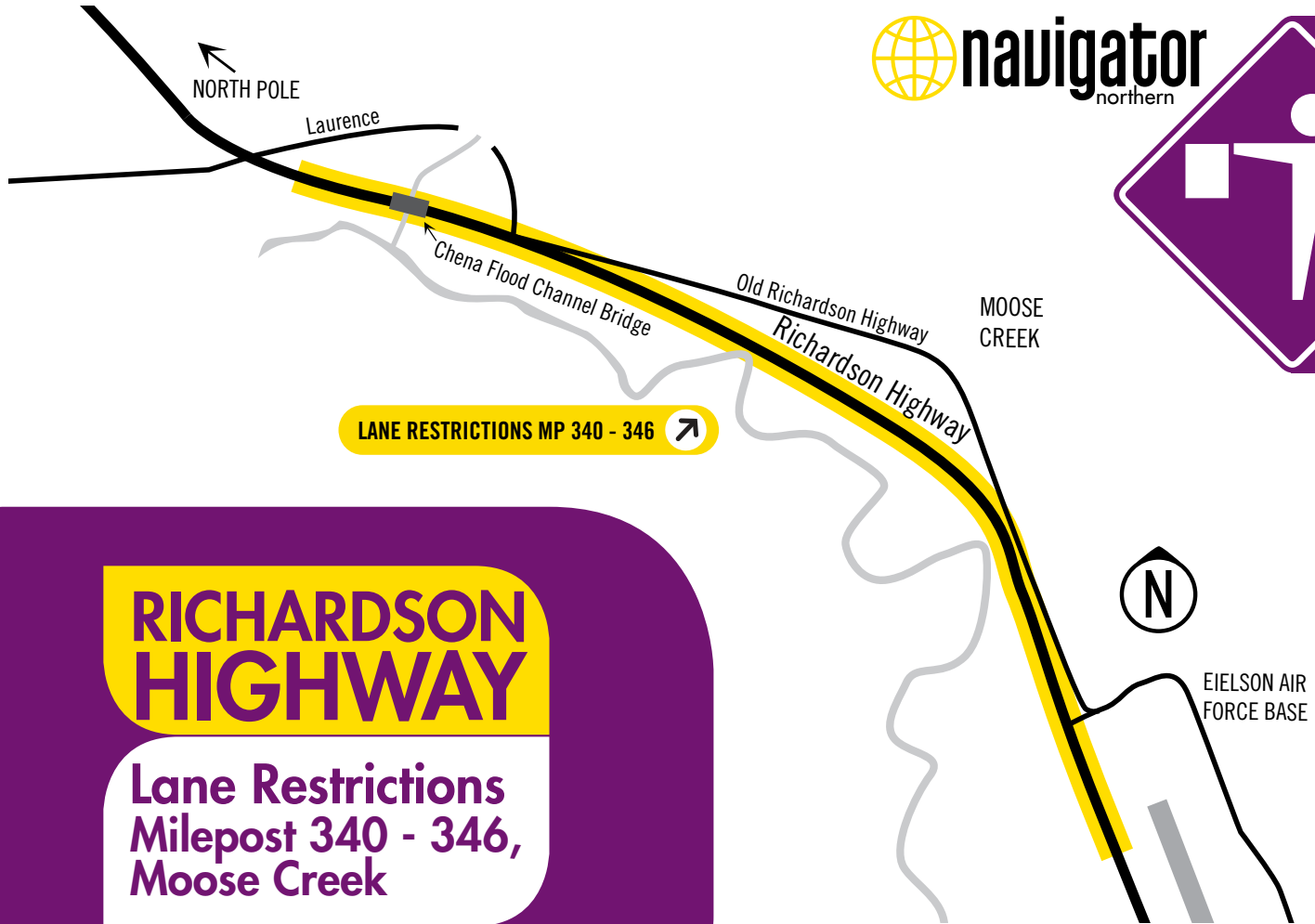

The Alaska Department of Transportation, in partnership with Great Northwest, Inc., is working to resurface the Richardson Highway at Moose Creek from MP 340 - 346 and rehabilitate the Chena Flood Channel Bridge. Work will include re-paving this stretch of the highway, and bridge maintenance - including installing new bridge safety railing. We will do our best to keep you informed as work continues and appreciate your patience and cooperation during construction. This project is scheduled to be complete by August 2012.

- **ROAD CLOSURE:** Beginning Tuesday, May 1, northbound lanes on the Richardson Highway, between MP 340 to 346, will be **CLOSED**. All traffic, traveling in both directions, will be moved to the southbound lanes until early June. Business access will remain open.
- Throughout construction, expect intermittent LANE RESTRICTIONS, flagging operations, and DELAYS.
