PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Upper Tanana Airport Planning Study (UTAPS) will examine several road system airports in the Upper Tanana region to determine how to best accommodate the uses in each project area that can meet the needs of all or most users. The airports primarily under consideration are those in Tok, Tanacross, Northway, and Gulkana.

Currently, each airport serves a different role in its community, so the study will consider a variety of factors such as location, size and stakeholder needs.

Understanding how stakeholders use airports within the region is an important aspect of the investigation. Stakeholder and public input will be solicited in several ways: targeted interviews with key stakeholders, a broadly distributed survey, and public meetings.
