Some Things Have Changed:

Snow Removal Equipment Building (SREB) is relocating from the previously proposed location near Taxiway A to Lot 13, next to the apron.

Environmental Document: The class of action has changed from an Environmental Assessment to a Categorical Exclusion.

Why were these changes made?

The <u>SREB location</u> was adjusted to minimize impacts on wetlands and nearby water bodies.

The reduction in the <u>environmental</u> <u>document</u> classification is due to the decreased impacts from the new SREB location.
