

Haines Airport Rehabilitation and Snow Removal Equipment Building

NOTICE OF CHANGE



The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Alaskan Region of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), is proposing to rehabilitate the Haines Airport.

The purpose of the project is to extend the service life of the Haines Airport, improve safety for aircraft operations and taxiing, improve airport access, and improve drainage.

Some Things Have Changed:

Snow Removal Equipment Building (SREB) is relocating from the previously proposed location near Taxiway A to Lot 13, next to the apron.

Environmental Document: The class of action has changed from an Environmental Assessment to a Categorical Exclusion.

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Why were these changes made?

The [SREB location](#) was adjusted to minimize impacts on wetlands and nearby water bodies.

The reduction in the [environmental document](#) classification is due to the decreased impacts from the new SREB location.
