



King Salmon Airport Apron & Taxiway Pavement Rehabilitation

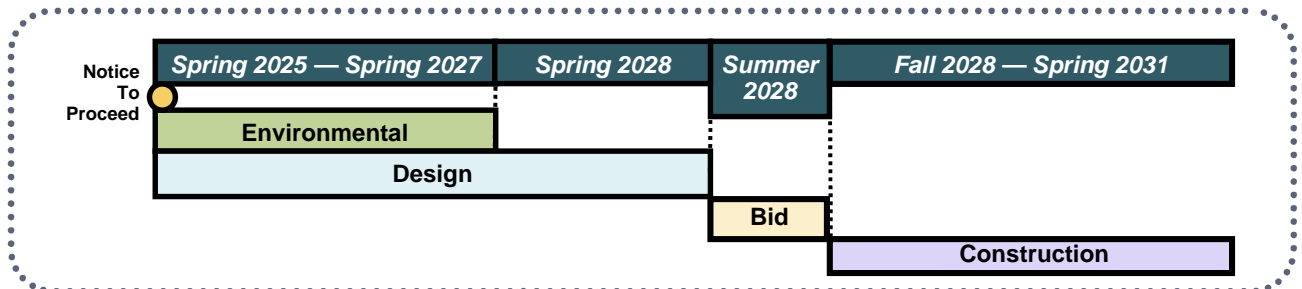

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) Southcoast Region is proposing to rehabilitate the pavement for various Aprons and Taxiways at the King Salmon Airport. The project will also replace the lighting system at the airport, including the lighted wind cone and lighted signs. The project is kicking off and is in the early part of the design phase. DOT&PF has informed Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Alaskan Region of their intent to apply for federal funding assistance for the proposed project.

DOT&PF is seeking input from airport users and the public. DOT&PF and Jacobs Engineering Group will be hosting a public open house. Stop by to learn about the project, meet the design team, and provide comments.

KING SALMON AIRPORT APRON & TAXIWAY REHABILITATION (PROJECT NO. SFAPT00563)

PROJECT SCOPE:

- 1 REHABILITATE PAVEMENT AND REPLACE MARKINGS FOR TAXIWAYS A, D, G, THE WEST SIDE OF TAXIWAY C, THE SOUTH SIDE OF TAXIWAY A, GENERAL AVIATION APRON, AND AIR CARRIER APRONS.
- 2 REPLACE LIGHTING FOR AIR CARRIER APRON, GENERAL AVIATION APRON, AND CARGO APRON.
- 3 REPLACE LIGHTING FOR TAXIWAYS A, B, C, D, E, AND G.
- 4 REPLACE LIGHTING FOR RUNWAY 18-36 AND RUNWAY 12-30.
- 5 REPLACE THE PRIMARY WINDCONE.
- 6 REPLACE THE LIGHTED DISTANCE-TO-GO SIGNS FOR RUNWAY 12-30.
- 7 RUN AN UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL CONNECTION FROM THE AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING BUILDING TO THE EMERGENCY GENERATOR APPROXIMATELY 800 FEET AWAY.
- 8 REPLACE TIE-DOWNS ON GENERAL AVIATION APRON
