This meeting is to inform the public of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) intended Section 4(f) Evaluation and Approval for Transportation Projects That Have a Net Benefit to a Section 4(f) Property for the SGY: State Street Rehabilitation project.

The project area is within the Skagway and White Pass National Historic Landmark (NHL), NHLs are historic properties identified as nationally significant in American history and culture and are therefore eligible for protection under Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966. Proposed activities within the NHL include resurfacing State Street pavement, repairing subgrade at selected locations, replacing and upgrading curbs, installing ADA compliant curb ramps, driveway cuts and sidewalks, installing new signage and road striping, and replacing culverts and the storm drain system. Construction is expected to begin in 2024. The Section 4(f) Evaluation includes a consideration of impacts, alternatives, and mitigation options along with coordination with the National Park Service and the State Historic Preservation Office.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by DOT&PF pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated April 13, 2023, and executed by FHWA and DOT&PF.
