## Form 25D-60B Instructions:

- 1. Enter the project name, state number, and federal project number as they appear on the contract.
- 2. Match the description from the related Form 25D-62, if applicable. Enter "NONE" on the first line if there are no non-compliant items to declare.
- 3. The invoice cost as delivered to the project, including freight, of materials subject to 23 CFR 635.410. The contract allowance is one-tenth of one percent (0.1 percent) of the total contract amount at award, or \$2,500, whichever is greater, per 23 CFR 635.410(b)(4).
- 4. The contract allowance for Manufactured Products and Construction Materials is no more than the lesser of \$1,000,000 or 5% of the total applicable costs for the project (as defined by the NEPA finding, determination, or decision) per the USDOT Waiver of Buy America Requirements for De Minimis Costs and Small Grants (88 FR 55817).
- 5. Attach additional form sheets if necessary to include more than one page of items.
- 6. Enter the total cost of all predominantly steel and iron products, manufactured products, and construction materials to be permanently incorporated into the project.
