Form 25D-60-U Instructions:

- 1. Enter the project name, state number, and federal number as they appear on the Utility Agreement.
- 2. Match the description from the related form 25D-62-U. Enter "NONE" on the first line if there are no non-domestic products or construction materials to declare.
- 3. The invoice cost as delivered to the project, including freight, of materials subject to 23 CFR 635.410. The Minimal Use allowance for the agreement is calculated as one-tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the total agreement amount, or \$2,500, whichever is greater, per 23 CFR 635.410(b)(4).
- 4. The invoice cost as delivered to the project, including freight, of materials subject to Federal Register at 88 FR 55817. The De Minimis allowance for the agreement is calculated as five percent (5%) of the total applicable material costs for the agreement, or \$1,000,000, whichever is less.
- 5. Attach additional form sheets if necessary to include more than one page of products and materials.
- 6. Enter the total cost of all iron and steel, including Predominantly Iron and Steel items referenced in Appendix A to the Utility Agreement, and construction materials to be permanently incorporated into the project.
